### **AHCA to Announce Findings from 39 Care Facility Visits in Greater Jacksonville Area** *--Teams reviewed for Medicaid billing compliance, safety of residents--*

**Tallahassee, Fla.**— On Friday, October 19, officials from the Agency for Health Care Administration will hold a press conference to announce the findings of inspections to 39 care facilities—all assisted living facilities or adult family care homes—in the greater Jacksonville area. This week, the Agency made unannounced visits to all active Medicaid Assistive Care Service providers in Duval, Clay, Nassau, St. John and Putnam Counties to review records and determine if the providers were rendering, billing and documenting services in accordance with Medicaid policy, and ensure health and safety of the residents in the facilities.
